

## **An Andalusian town fights unemployment with the union of the neighbour in an asparagus cooperative**

LOCATION: Montefrío (Granada)

DURATION: 1:30

**SUMMARY:** The Andalusian town of Montefrío, located in the province of Granada, has reached this spring the goal of many other towns: full employment. This has been thanks to the green asparagus campaign, that started weeks ago and that will last for another two months; and to the creation of a cooperative integrated by its neighbours. 1.300 jobs have been created in this campaign in a town with 6.000 inhabitants.
