



**An Andalusian radio for kids gives disadvantaged children from Morocco and Latin-America the chance to be heard**

**LOCATION:** Mairena del Aljarafe (Seville)

**VTR:** 1'43"

**SUMMARY:** Miniature-radio is an online radio station program made by 5 to 12 year olds with the aim of creating a link between the eight participating countries; it is an educational project for peace. The initiative was born in the town of Mairena del Aljarafe (Seville) with the support of a neighborhood association and the support of countries such as Germany, Colombia, México, Guatemala, the Dominican Republic, Argentina and Morocco, where with the exception of Germany, children live with risk of poverty or violence around them. The compromise of their teachers has been such that at times they have endangered their own lives by defying curfews to air the program or other critical circumstances. With this program children learn about their rights but most of all they learn to gain self-esteem and dignity.
