

“LORCA, HOW I WANT YOU LORCA”: A VIRTUAL BOOK BRINGS TOGETHER 40 SCHOOLS NATIONWIDE AROUND THE POET FROM GRANADA

SUMMARY: The Enriquez Barrios School has promoted the creation of a virtual book around the poet Federico Garcia Lorca in which more than 40 schools in Spain, as well as a school from Argentina, have participated. The multimedia material used has been developed by students of all ages, students as young as 5 years old that already work at ease with new technologies. The book has earned an award from the education office because it promotes reading habits.
