

Health workers in Córdoba develop an innovative system for ambulances 2.0

LOCATION: Córdoba

DURATION: 1'40"

SUMMARY: Two health workers from Córdoba have developed a system that permits emergency physicians having access to the medical records of patient while they arrive to the hospital by ambulance. This way they minimize the risk or error, knowing the medication they are taking, if they have any allergy... In case they try to give the patient drugs which aren't suitable for him, the system emits an alert. All the ambulances of the Andalusian health system are equipped with these innovative tablets.

Ambience: Data allocation. Go to Pintor Espinosa Street number 6, province of Córdoba. Data of the patient. Women. Aged 28 years old. Name María.

They know the name of the patient before arriving, and through this tablet they have access to his medical record.
