

A deal against school dropout: I teach you how to work if you finish your studies

SUMMARY: Ten teenagers of the Carmen Laffón high school at San José de la Rinconada, in Seville participate in a program that intends to avoid school dropout. It has been promoted by the CIC Batá NGO and the Provincial Council of Seville. Three hundred teenagers have participated in this program since it was started in 2004 and almost a 99% have finished their studies.
