

Innovative teaching that involves families awarded by UNESCO

SUMMARY: Francisco Cid is a teacher from the Quintanilla Public School, located in San Fernando, Cádiz. He received the Award to Excellency and Innovation in Education 2016 given by the World Association of Early Childhood Educators, an entity under UNESCO. This award recognised a method that he began to apply in 2009 with the intention of making families get involved in the student's education. It is based on questions that interest or worry first graders, which are registered to work on them during second and third grade, with a frequency of one per week, basing on activities designed by the families in collaboration with the teacher.

VTR:

Francisco Cid, a teacher from Cádiz. Seven years ago he began to apply a teaching method that makes the families of his students get involved in their education. Now the World Association of Early Childhood Educators has recognised his innovative capacity.
