SUMMARY: "Different Worlds" ("Mundos diferentes"), a comic regarding the deaf community is one of the projects that have become a reality thanks to Goteo Andalusia, a collective micro-financing platform of the Guadalinfo Network. 80% of the projects of this program have reached their objectives since it was started, just one year ago.
