

Solidarity coaching to promote employment among youngsters at risk of social exclusion

LOCATION: Sevilla

DURATION: 1'34"

SUMMARY: Since it was started in May, a solidarity initiative whose goal is the labor insertion of young people at risk of social exclusion, has helped seven youngsters finding a job. It is a project promoted by the NGO Action Against Hunger and the Santa María La Real Foundation, in which 20 people from marginal areas of Seville participate. They use coaching sessions to emotionally prepare them for the job seeking, to teach them time management or how to write their CV.
