



Ness: instant hot water thanks to a device that reduces the bill up to a 40%

LOCATION: Málaga

DURATION: 1'29"

SUMMARY: Ness is a device developed by a company in Málaga, Métrica 6, to save water. It makes hot water run since the moment we open the tap, so we can use it immediately. This system permits saving 800 litres a month per person and reduces the water bill up to a 40%.

VTR:

This is a usual picture in every home. We waste water since the moment we open the tap until the water acquires the temperature we desire. This device, invented by a new company in Málaga, avoids this.

The Ness device heats the water before it comes out of the tap; it is electronic and works with every type of furnaces. A switch is what makes it work.
