

## Almond blossoms to awaken the senses and revive rural tourism in Almería

LOCATION: Lucainena de las Torres (Almería)

**SUMMARY:** Los Filabres-Alhamilla, a region in Almería, plays a key role in the Almond Blossom Trails, a project which promotes rural tourism through its main attraction at this time of year: almond blossom. These days are aimed at getting to know the countryside, conveying the local desire for sustainable development of agriculture and livestock, and also promoting their historical and cultural past.

**VTR:** Almond blossom is the main feature of a very special trail, a trail dedicated to the senses. The region in Almería of Los Filabres-Alhamilla has designed a tour based on the beautiful blossoming of this fruit tree, that is committed to sustainable development of the area and promotion of rural tourism.

Almería is the second largest producer of almonds in Andalusia, with a cultivation surface of 60,000 hectares, a significant proportion found in this area.
