

VirTimePlace: past and present of monuments with an app that reconstructs them virtually

LOCATION: Mosque of Cordova

DURATION: 1'30"

SUMMARY: VirTimePlace is a new informative app, through which you can see and compare a place in the past with its current state. This system, through augmented reality, allows archaeological research on historical monuments and spaces to be transferred to a virtual recreation of their time. The user will be able to access and walk through recreated monuments and cultural spaces, in the most authentic way possible, in a 3D virtual space.

Imagine what it would be like walking through the 10th Century Mosque of Cordova? An app designed by this man from Cordova makes this journey into the past possible. It's a free app for mobile devices which recreates spaces and monuments as they were hundreds of years ago.
