



An app to map the flora at the Alcázar of Seville, guiding visitors through history

LOCATION: Seville

SUMMARY: The gardens of the Alcázar of Seville have more than 1,000 years of history. In them, doctors from Al Andalus researched the health effects of plants. Later, botanists experimented here with seeds from the Americas. A new app maps the plants of this famous historical space and transmits information to the user on their origins and history to date.
