



Ruwomed: empowering women from Palestine and Lebanon with visits to Andalusian cooperatives

LOCATION: Montejaque (Málaga)

DURATION: 1'40"

SUMMARY: Ruwomed is the name of a European project that is developed by the Assembly of Cooperation for Peace that pursues the empowerment of women in rural areas of Palestine and Lebanon. Within the program, these women have traveled to Spain to get to know cooperative initiatives similar to theirs.

VTR:

The employment rate of women in rural areas of Lebanon and Palestine is less than 25%. Women from these territories have traveled to Spain to get to know similar initiatives to the ones they want to begin. The program Ruwomed has brought them to this cooperative in Malaga.
