



SCAN: global promotion of Spanish contemporary art through social media

LOCATION: La Carolina (Jaén)

DURATION: 1'31''

SUMMARY: Three Andalusian architects –from La Carolina (Jaén), Almería and Morón de la Frontera (Seville)—and one New Yorker have launched in London, the first platform to promote emerging Spanish contemporary art. In a little over a year, they have created a directory with more than 140 artists and established contact in fifty countries. In the summer of 2015 the works have leaped from social networks to the three exhibition centers in London with the exhibit “Saturation.”

To give global attention to emerging Spanish contemporary art. This is the goal of a digital platform born in London in 2014, thanks to three Andalusian architects and one New Yorker.

They do not sell art. They are the link between artists and galleries. Their directory has over 140 artists selected by exhibition curators such as Manuela Villa, Sema D’Acosta and Pablo del Val.
