

## **Wimic, a device which lets you know when you forget your keys or someone steals your wallet**

**SUMMARY:** The Grenadian Business Dasware has developed a device named 'Wimic' which acts as a portable alarm that you can put on your keys, in your wallet or in your bag. The device notifies the owner if they move too far away from the object, or if someone tries to steal it.

### **VTR:**

A device which notifies you through your phone if you forget your wallet, or if someone tries to steal your jacket when you're not looking. Its name is 'Wimic' and these young entrepreneurs designed it in Grenada.

The device is placed on whatever object you like and the alarm will sound on your phone if you get a certain distance away from said object, which the user sets. Another option is to put it on a jacket or in a bag and the alarm sounds if someone handles those objects. One of the challenges has been to make the device as small as possible.

The user sets the device through a mobile app. Being able to set a security perimeter, it can be used on children in the park so they don't go too far away, and in the same sense with pets.
