



Open air art to preserve a national heritage sight

LOCATION: Carchelejo, Jaén

DURATION: 1'47"

SUMMARY: 'Opened by art' is a project from the Huerta Friars Association situated in Carchelejo, Jaen, which, for two weeks, looks to support open air sculptural creations in an area dedicated to agroecology. The project is overlooked by the University of Granada Fine Arts Faculty whose professors select the projects and guide the artists in their creative process. Writers of diverse backgrounds are taking part in this experiment.

VTR:

Creativity in the open air. That is the philosophy which inspired Opened by Art, the project which is being developed in Huerta de los Frailes, in Carchelejo, Jaen, an area in which creativity and agroecology are combined to preserve the surrounding environment through a foundation.

For two weeks a year, they award a grant to a group of artists with space, materials and support to create a sculpture that will help to shape the countryside.
