SUMMARY: Black on Black is a theater company born in Castilleja de Guzman, in Seville. They develop black theater, an unusual genre in Spain. But the truth is that what makes them special is that all of the members are unemployed people with problems, and in many cases are socially excluded. For them, the theater is a therapy and, above all, a way to build a future career. After months of formation and rehearsal, they have already released their first production: "The Little Prince".
